They were joined to three Moorobie stud Angus bulls with the bull individual ID's listed in the assessment. The cows range from 26% small frame through to 37% medium and 37% large frame. All these cows were vendor mouthed in April 2022 with 9 x 2 T, 4 x 4T, 3 x 6T, 8 x 8T at that time. All the 8T cows were remouthed at assessment with all sound 8T cows (see photos). Based on dentition it is estimated that 65% of the cows are 2 - 4 years old with balance 6 - 8 years old. Eyes, feet and udders all appeared sound and in line with the age of the cows. These cows are being sold as they are outside the vendors preferred calving window. They suit to take and put away with the cows to throw soft crossbred calves in an autumn 2023 calving.
