Steers are out of vendor bred medium framed cows, vendor has been using Angus sires since 1993, there are some of these steers showing signs of generational crosses. Please note, at least 2 steers observed with small scur horn, at least 5 have varying degree of white on cod to navel area, 5 steers I observed were being "proud" they are steers, just may of been marked late. 2 steers seen with wart and ringworm. Some steers do have clover seed in dead hair on bellies or on their polls. Nothing considered detrimental . Vendor also offering 40 heifers in todays sale, sisters to these.
