Very tidy around the head with a large majority of polls. 1 Angus cross steer, a black Brahman D/M cross, 15 steers with slight brahman content showing moderate crest/hump - all good quality. 3 steers with very minor ringworm (clearing) 1 white underline & feet. 11 steers belong to another family member & are pure Rondel Droughtmaster bred & blood.
