Assessor Comments Buyers a light deck load of PCAS ELIGIBLE Angus and Angus cross heifers that show good quality and will suit restockers looking to rebuild numbers and continue to breed from. They show pretty good weight for age but are not really carrying any excess fat coverage and have come through a very wet winter well, they are just starting to clean up in the coat and are really starting to bounce ahead now the feed has dried out a little bit. Would expect some pretty rapid weight gains in the short term. They would also suit feedlots for the domestic market. Noted at assessment a few with eye blemishes: one with just a light cloudy eye, one with old blue eye scarring and another two with a recent blight issue that looks to be healing up. Also saw about five with old ring worm scarring mainly on the head/neck. All in all, a tidy line that can be put together with two other lots being offered in the sale with delivery at the same yards. All up 73 head to allow buyers to fill decks.
