Health management of these steers is more than adequate as they have received multiple vaccinations including Multimin, 7 in 1, 5 in 1, Vitamin A,D&E and multiple drenches. August/September 2021 drop. These steers are of medium to large frames and display even depth and composition throughout their bodies. A great article to take on over the Spring and Summer months to continue to power ahead in weight gain and fat cover turning into ideal feeder or kill cattle stock.
