Vendor said they are good to handle in the paddock, just a little unsettled when first yarded.

Assessor Comments	A nice line of EU Angus steers that are growing well, just starting to clean up and are ready to go. These steers were assessed in two different sets of yards, 6hd were trucked the day after assessment to join the others at Tallangatta Valley. They are Greenham Never Ever Grass Fed Accredited. The steers have come out of a cold, wet winter and are now really starting to pick up in condition. These steers were a little unsettled when being videoed due to unfamiliar people on foot in their paddock, but settled when popped back to their own paddock. All these steers have banded tails to identify them. There is the odd steer showing old ringworm around the head. 1 steers has an old pinkeye scar, not detrimental to him. NOTE - Vendor also has another 2 lots at his Tallangatta Valley property - 62 steers & 40 heifers, and a further 2 lots at his Mudgegonga property - 32 steers & 25 heifers.
