Heifers are showing great weight for age and have been weaned and handled ready go on with. Heifers have been exposed to Angus bulls while they were followers on the cows. Heifers would highly suit both the breeder and the feedlotter. Buyers, please note there is a Blackall weaner sale on the 24th of November and the vendor has adjusted his delivery to aid an opportunity to purchase more cattle to fill up decks. In this consignment there is 1 heifer with a slightly enlarged naval and approximately 10 heifers with scarring from ring worm and 1 with a wart on the neck. I must clarify that the three heifers noted to have a Wagyu influence is only very slight and hardly noticeable. There are also 2 heifers with Ultrablack content that have brindle colouring (see photos).
