One cow has a old bog bite on n/s hind, one cow has old blight scarring in n/s eye, one cow has had its ear chewed by dingoes as a calf. These cows had been in the yards for 3 days being processed and fed hay & water of a evening and still averaged 446kg at assessment. The Calves on these cows are a credit to the breeder! they are well grown, castrated but no brand or ear mark with exception of 3 younger male calves. The property is sold so this is a genuine dispersal of breeders. Vendor also has another line of Breeders in this sale. I highly recommend these Breeders.
