Assessor Comments	Store conditioned heifers that have been bought, weaned and handled. These heifers are being sold due to the vendor being in a dry pocket and missing out on the rain. It is expected that these heifers would have been heavier but are not, due to the value of native pasture feed quality and the extended dry conditions in this area. It is expected these heifers would have large compensatory gain on improved nutrition. Most of these heifers would suit backgrounding for a trade job or taking through to heavy feeder or kill weights with the lead being suitable to retain as breeders if required. Please note, Photos and videos were taken in the rain, there are a further 38 predominantly Angus heifers off the same property in the same sale with another vendor.
