In the race and crush they were very difficult to handle and exited the crush rapidly to return to the main mob. There was nothing considered aggressive however if they became isolated this could be a reality.

Assessor Comments	Buyers a line of F1 Wagyu/Angus cross steers that have presented in very plain condition. As a result I believe they would provide some degree of compensatory gain to the successful purchaser. They would suit a backgrounding operation to go onto crop to pick them up a bit and maybe add some vitamin supplements to aide in their recovery from the extended dry conditions they have endured. In the line I noted five steers that have been castrated late and still has a ring and purse attached. The facilities didn't allow any to be mouthed. There is a total of 106 being offered in two lines and they were weighed and drafted off the crush over/under 230kgs. All details of the bulls used over the cows to produce these steers has been attached for your perusal.
