These steers were weighed in a weigh box & then assessed in crush. A small portion became agitated in crush as expected due to not being through set up since animal health treatments. Steers were 2 wayed out the front of crush as no round yard was used.

Assessor Comments	Genuine line of VENDOR BRED, ONE MARK , SEPT drop 22, PURE BRED Angus weaner steers presenting in strong store condition. Butheroo Angus program has allows been heavily sought after by numerous feedlots as they have the renown Angus genetics (Temania, Booramooka, Coffin Creek & Eagle hawk). No Butheroo weaner steers have hit the open market for restockers until NOW due to the dry conditions. With spring around the corner these angus steers can be utilised to hit numerous targets. These steers were the younger/lighter calves out of 300 which were drafted out due to not having enough crop to feed all of them. Note: Approx 36% of steers exhibited ring worms on neck, nose & eye region which is caused by nutrition & stress of weaning. Since going on feed mix steers are starting to recover naturally quickly. 15 % of steers displayed fresh pink eye in 1 eye & 3 head were deemed to be severely active. Please view photos & videos for better description but both are deemed non detrimental.
