	Weaner steers moved fairly quietly through yards provided it was done a slow pace. Under pressure they behaved like a typical weaner with a tendency to move quickly from a few ring leaders, especially if they became isolated from the main mob. Handled reasonably well through the force and race but did resent being up close and personal on the scales in the crush. These are expected to settle further whilst being fed in the yards.

Assessor Comments	Buyers, presented is a great opportunity to purchase a neat 2 deck line of freshly weaned flatback crossbred steers. These steers would be ideal to put onto a fresh paddock or crop with all of their conformity around bone, depth and structure presented. Given the opportunity these animals would grow into the ideal item for entry weight to the feedlot, backgrounder or to carry through to bullocks. As mentioned the steers were recently yard weaned and fed oaten hay and dry grass. Temperament and handling of these steers has included the ability of a short truck trip between station yards. One steer was noted to have slightly higher male characteristics with no stone visibly noticed but will be double checked prior to delivery.
