This is a very even line of ideal feeder weight steers, which are just starting to clean up in the coat, & are very forward in condition, with shape & softness in abundance. These steers are very well balanced, exhibiting very good body length & depth, possessing the depth of bone and squareness to develop into very meaty calves at the back end of a finishing program. Steers are very quiet, calm & well handled, & would adapt very quickly to a feedlot induction period, minimising weight loss in the adjustment period & thereby maximising profit through earlier weight gains.
