A line of 5 lightweights under 260 kg have been drafted out of this line, and would be available for private sale to the successful purchaser, if so desired. A fair number of these heifers are still showing signs of their winter coats, with very few warm days been experienced here to date. The Tooperangus stud is based on Te Mania foundations, with an emphasis in calving ease and high growth rates. A great opportunity to pick up a line of outstanding future breeders.
