Assessor Comments	Buyers, a small lot of good quality Angus cross steers. These are in store condition, bred on lighter country and are just starting to clean up in the coat so I would expect these to provide plenty of compensatory gain and fly ahead if they get access to good quality feed or crop on some heavier country. These steers are very quiet and the vendor's always do an excellent job throughout the weaning process and is reflected in these. They are ideal to background to heavier domestic or export feeder weights. There is a bit of a weight range which is quite common and is a reflection of the gap in their age of 7-11 months. These don't look to have had any setbacks, it did get dry here back in the spring but were weaned later to give them every chance to grow out.
