Tidy heads with good moderate frame and plenty of bone these steers will continue to perform for prospective purchasers and offer options right through from feeders to grass bullocks. Small percentage mouthed with any #2's noted mouthed at assessment to be 100% milk tooth. Small percentage of steers showing higher Bos Indicus content with minimal hump height and cleaner coats. these steers are highly suited to the southern markets and are good easy doers with plenty of scope to continue their growth.
