These heifers had a tough start to life as it didn't start to rain here until about October 2023, prior to that they were on rations. They have really bounced away in a big way since the rain started. Heifers exhibit softness, plenty of length, depth of barrel and plenty of femininity. They will make top class replacement breeders for a restocker wishing to purchase a line of very even red heifers. The vendors are not frightened to spend money on the right genetics, always looking to move their herd forward, not just marking time & it certainly shines through in these.
