These are in fresh condition, however being bred on lighter country I would envisage these to fly ahead if they get access to good quality feed or crop on some heavier country. Steers are very quiet, the vendor's always do an excellent job throughout the weaning process and is reflected in this line. Ideal to background to heavier domestic or export feeder weights and present in a nice tight weight range. They definitely haven't had any setbacks and the photos/video will indicate they possess plenty of length, depth of barrel, bone and muscle development for such young steers.
