Bred from a cow base that has a foundation of Speriby North, Bald Blair, Wattle Top and Glenavon Angus bloodlines steers have the right genetics for performance in the feedlot or grow out and finish for the accredited grass fed programs. Steers have been weighed into a tight weight range for ease of selling out the other end, 162 - 235 full at assessment with a tail removed. Steers are well handled and will steam ahead given a rising plain of nutrition. Pleas see another line of 44 steers that are just in a Heavier bracket, Combine the two for a neat two decks of backgrounders.
