Given heifers are on good pasture but very wet conditions for grass to have a strong body the cattle are "slippery". It is expected that they would travel with at least one spell over 1000km. Heifers are all fresh, in strong condition. Recommend trucking at 35 to a deck therefore 2 deck in mob. Can be adjusted if purchaser buys both lots in this sale to suite B double unit.
