These Speckle Park cross steers have been sired by WATTLE GROVE Speckle Park sires (WGS P110 & WGS M153), presenting with good evenness & consistency of shape across the mob. They are out of large framed cows, & possess the breeding potential to develop into export weight steers, whilst still maintaining the carcass shape & early maturity required to finish into Trade markets as yearlings. These steers would normally be grown out into either feeder weights or finished into domestic trade kill markets depending on available feed, however, vendor has brought about the early sale of this years drop, to conserve feed for cows. Attractive, quiet cattle that would perform equally well for both a backgrounding/feedlot operation, or a fattening enterprise.
