	Weaner steers moved fairly quietly through yards provided it was done a slow pace. Under pressure they behaved like a typical weaner with a tendency to move quickly from a few ring leaders, especially if they became isolated from the main mob. Handled reasonably well through the force and race but did resent being up close and personal on the scales in the crush. These are expected to settle further whilst being fed in the yards.

Assessor Comments	Buyers, presented is a great opportunity to purchase a 2-deck line of good quality, freshly weaned mainly flatback crossbred steers. Most of the steers appear to be flatback type however there are some steers with some Droughtmaster content and consequently a slight crest and longer ear. These steers would be ideal to put into a fresh paddock or on crop. They are nice soft steers and show signs of developing to possess plenty of bone, depth of barrel and muscling like the heavier steers offered in the sale. These steers are an ideal proposition for a backgrounding operation to take through to either domestic or export feedlot entry weights. Please note there is also a 1-deck line of heavier steers also in the sale to make up a B-Double load.
