Heifers were preg tested back in February and have been retested on the 21st of May confirming they are all 6 months plus in calf. Please note the vendor has another 20 PTIC heifers with an identical joining offered in the same sale providing the opportunity to put together an exceptional line of 57 females with all their lives ahead of them.
