A focus and emphasis is put on IMF, 600 day weight in the EBV traits when selecting bulls for the Glendon herd that then put over a classy line of large frame Angus cows. Steers are thick and stand on good bone that would handle a long fed program. Being EU, Grass fed eligible and Antibiotic free there is not a domestic or export end market that steers will not fit, Prefect weight for the feedlot or quality steers to finish on grass.
