Approx 26% Ewes & 31% Wethers from this 2022 Drop were classed out & are now for sale. The Wether portion weighed 42 - 69 kg to av 55.5 kg (40 head weighed). The Ewe portion weighed 45 - 66 kg to av 55.3 kg (43 head weighed). Approx 50% of the Wethers are unmulsed with the other 50% of the Wethers & all Ewes moderately Mulsed. There were 2 assessed Wethers noticed with an undershot jaw.
