Assessor Comments	A lovely line of 60 x Sep/ Oct 2023 Drop Landfall & Bongongo Blood Angus Steers. The steers present well as a group and represent the lead of the Bukalong 2023 drop, a tail was removed at assessment. The steers handle well and exhibit sound temperament typical of well educated weaners. Born on the vendors property at Delegate, the steers have been running on grazing wheat at Bungendore since the start of May. Currently gaining between .9 to 1.1kg/ day the steers are perfectly set up to continue weight gain into the spring to reach feedlot entry later in the year. Approx 15 head exhibit ring worm scarring and 2 head were noted with faint eye scarring. A great opportunity to secure 60 x vendor bred steers and another 29 x steers of similar quality and weight, run under the same conditions.
