The heifers are all vendor bred at either the vendors property in the Richmond district or at Salisbury creek. The heifers had a liveweight range of 420 to 600 kg full weight. Please note that two heifers have rub marks on the neck & face, not seen as detrimental. The heifers were mostly good to handle in the yards and crush. These are quality vendor bred heifers joined to good quality Angus bulls that should grow into good quality future breeders.
