They offer a buyer with some improved pasture, winter herbage, or even better an oats crop, an opportunity for a huge amount of compensatory gain. In their current state they will zoom ahead very quickly as there is plenty of frame to fill up with condition. They would suit to take through to heavier export feedlot weights. For buyers operating in a tick free area these will have had 3 pre-treatments through a plunge dip that has been tested for strength. That dip report is attached to this assessment. The age of these steers is only an estimate as they are purchased steers however all mouthed for a more accurate indication.
