Originally joined with the intention of targeting the feature female sale in January as 'point of calving' females. An unforgiving season & a need for feed has meant these heifers paddocks will be cut for hay, and they need to find a new home. Heifers that present a perfect opportunity to take advantage of the current climate and improve the quality of an existing herd, or start out on the front foot with an impressive line of hard to fault females bred from the heart of the Scott's Angus herd.
