Steers show plenty of bone, length & depth and will continue to grow out to be excellent heavy feeders or grassfed bullocks given the opportunity to fresh feed or crop. This is an opportunity to buy a large run of one brand steers that will have been well educated in and outside the yards. Buyers please note some of these cattle have been in hand for up to two weeks at assessment so expect good compensatory gains. At assessment 1 x head noticed with some warts around the eye not seen as detrimental. Vendor also has other lines in the same sale.
