They are front paddock heifers, averaging 354.6kg at delivery, ready to join with the bull of your choice. While mustering and yarding all heifers were a pleasure to handle, with a placid temperament. Only a small handful stirred in the crush, however, settled immediately on release. Please note that one heifer does have a slight cut on the back left foot not deemed detrimental. Also note that the vendor has another lot of 14 quality heifers in the same sale.
