They are well bred and in fresh condition and will grow quickly add weight if shown quality feed. Calves show some signs on rubbing on shoulders, neck and rump. Approx 3% have very light blue colouring in eye but was not impairing vision. Calves are bred out of predominately Rennyalea, Coonamara and Te Mania Cows by various Angus sires (Connamara, Yukon Park, Texas Top Gun, HF Safe & Sound and Sound & Sydgen Bonus 8084).
