Steers weaned early winter onto grazing oats and show fresh healthy condition with most stock cleaned up shiny in coat and on the do. No faults observed and majority of steers show good body type development with a few lessor type and shape observed. Majority of cattle show flat back type with a minority showing some hump. All castrated with elastrator bands. A couple of steers with warts noticed on head. Any inferior and lessor types drafted off before assessment. Scales tested ok prior to weighing and checked at finish of weighing. These cattle flowed through yard at assessing with two people and showed no noticeable temperament issues.
