Due to this, we have probably seen the livestock struggle to do the minimum, but the tables have turned and these calves need to make way for the upcoming fodder harvest. There is probably a spread of 6 months of age over the line. Calves present in forward store to store condition and are starting to lose their winter coats and freshen up. There is the odd late marked steer that is still dropping his tool out of his sheath. Steers have all been treated with piliguard there is the odd steer with a pink eye scarring or shadow, deemed not detrimental in my opinion.
