These girls have been wintering in the hill country and present with plenty of frame in their working clothes and are bred out of volume females carrying Ardrossan, Hazeldean and Jarabee bloodlines with a reputation for progeny being noted performers in grass and feedlot environments. Noted a few heifers with old ringworm scarring around face and neck and a very odd heifer with white on udder/flank. Note a smaller than usual top was retained out of this group as future breeders and a 25 % tail end also removed. Greenham Never Ever accredited and PCAS Grass Declaration available at purchasers request. Heifers suited to take on and join for a breeding program or fatten in to heavy kill heifers.
