This line of heifers were purchased as yearlings, both locally & ex AuctionsPlus, as part of the vendors breeding operation, with the exception of 1 heifer purchased PTIC which calved out of sequence with another mob. Heifers present as moderate in frame, with approx 5 larger-framed & 3 smaller-framed heifers throughout. They are producing plenty of milk, which is evident in the fresh calves at foot. Heifers have been running continuously back with the TeMania Angus bulls since calving, however continued joining would be advisable due to the young age of the calves. Presenting in forward store condition these heifers are just starting to clean up in the coat with the warmer weather. A great opportunity to secure quality young breeders which have calved unassisted, with sappy Angus calves at foot & a lifetime of production ahead of them. Vendor has another line of 16 x 16 Composite / Angus 1st calvers also on offer this sale.
