They are predominantly british bred steers with a small bos Indicus influence in some of them still predominantly softer that will
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improve quickly on feed. Presenting in store condition coming through a dry autumn and winter fed on green pick and hay and are now really starting to go forward presenting in quite fresh condition, ideal to grown into feeder weights. They offer a good medium frame with good bone density being true to Angus type. Off types and rougher animals drafted out at assessment. They steers are all 2023 drops. They are well known for their doing ability and will perform well for those buyers looking for improver cattle to add value to their purchases.
