Bred out of large frame Kamora Park and Leachim blood ewes, an emphasis is put on +fat, high growth and bare breach when purchasing sires. Lambs will reach export weights with ease. Vendor hasn't muelsed for 5 years and lambs are plain around the breach. Lambs present in predominatly score 2 condition and have done well in a tight Winter.
