Steers have presented mostly in very plain condition from a tough winter whilst on the cows with little access to protein. Steers are not sappy little 'butter balls' so I would predict these will provide a stack of compensatory gain provided they have access to improved feed conditions. They are genetically very sound cattle and should reach their full potential with the ability to grow out and muscle up as they mature.
