There is also a B-Double of heavier weight steers at this property available or a further two lots (6 decks) of Angus steers located at Aberdeen only about 40kms away that can be used to go with these. These have in the past had access to grain so aren't available to be used for grassfed slaughter markets. These were yarded about 14 hours prior to assessment but were on water and had access to silage in the yards so please treat as full at assessment.
