Assessor Comments	60 Watervalley Angus and Angus Cross steers to average 279.8 kg Curfewed. This line of steers are the off types that have been taken out of the main line of Watervalley Black Angus steers over the past few drafts. The steers consist of 30 Black steers with a brownish tinge in the coat, 23 Steers with small scur, 5 Steers with a brindle coloured coat and a few steers with white bellies. (Buyers could dehorn the scurs and the majority of the cattle could pass as an Angus type for the feedlots.) Individually weighed and drafted over the scales 240 to 360 kg, we decided to add the 300-360 kg LW steers together to make a line to suit a 2 deck load. PLEASE NOTE; The 8 x red steers are being offered in a separate assessment. Presenting as fresh stores supporting a good medium frame capable of fast weight gains given opportunity. Watervalley cattle are well known for their doing ability and will perform well for those buyers looking for improver cattle to add value to their purchases.
