These steers have great bone, weight and growth for age and would excel on the right feed as dry conditions have come and are still doing 0.550 ADG mob average. Great line of steers to background into heavy feeder market or processing markets. These cattle have great depth and capacity and are noted for their doing ability year in year out in feedlots. Steers are 100% grass-fed and antibiotic free. Steers would normally be retained to heavy feeder weights. Odd steer has old pinkeye scarring, considered not detrimental. *** Please note a draft of 81 head of the same weigh range in this sale***
