Showing great growth for age and have been averaging 1.2kg DWG since weaning in a tough year. Around 1/2 of these calves are AI bred by the \$240,000 Landfall Signature Sire purchased by Dunoon. Please note there are 5 steers that were late cut and still showing some pizzelle but will grow out and not be detrimental, there were 6 Steers noted with old pinkeye scarring but still have sight in the eye (see last photo for worst example). There is also a small amount of warts on a few steers and white underneath around 40% of draft. One Steer has an old abscess lump under jaw (see photo) and the purchaser has the right to leave out if desired. Grass fed & Antibiotic free declaration available on request.
