These weaners are shining in the coat after a great start to life with the season only recently starting to run out. They have been running on renowned top quality heavy clay country that has benefitted from flood waters in 2024. These heifers are well grown for age (270-369kg) and representing the seconds of the drop. 30% were retained as breeders and a 12% tail removed at assessment. They were yard weaned on clover based hay for 8 days. 2 head were treated for pinkeye at assessment and will not be delivered if they are not clearing up. Given conditions the odd weepy eye is expected at delivery. They are settled in the yards and content with human interaction. These heifers would be suited to a trade or breeding program. 100% grass fed and antibiotic free. Vendor is offering steers in today's sale also.
