Mumblebone blood for over 40 years the Possamunga sheep traditionally grow out to be big framed wethers but due to seasonal conditions have put these 4 to 5 month old wethers up for sale. At assessment I mouthed a portion of wethers all to be solid milk teeth. Of the portion that were assessed 11% was A frame, 56% B, 31% C and 2% D framed and also 77% were polled and 23% where horned. Wethers at weaning where backlined with Click on the 20th December 2024. Ideal to grow out, get a wool clip off and take onto heavier slaughter weights. Vendor also has other lot in National Sheep Sale.
