There are two shearings in this mob the 20th of December & 6th of January. Since being weaned in early December and placed onto a Summer Crop these lambs have gone ahead. The Composite ewe lamb portion of these lambs are approved OJD Vaccinates and have also had a light Mulesing. All of these Lambs have received a 5in1, a Scabigard & were drenched with a triple Combination at weaning. Grain trained on Barley approx. 3kg per week (Trail fed). White Suffolk cross lambs are sired by Waratah White Suffolk rams selected on Muscle, shape and fat, bred out of Probreed Highland Composite ewes with an emphasis on moderate frame & fertility. Shorn lambs that are grain trained and shouldn't take long to finish.
