Assessor Comments	4 deck line of mixed age Station mated Dorper, Dorper cross and Aussie white ewes with 15 laf. Line of ewes is made up from 2 lines of ewes from the Molong & Parkes NSW areas, purchased as SiL and station mated ewes last winter. These ewes adapted to the area and thrived on the fresh winter feed and raised very nice lambs, lambs were weaned and ewes re-joined but due to drying conditions have been offered for sale. Ewes have been mated to quality Dell, Red rock & Annalara white dorper rams. Ewes were purchased as mixed age but had all been mouthed sound before delivery as the tag colours don't reflect the age of some or all ewes, these ewes range from strong forward store to prime condition and don't appear to have any teeth issues. The ewes mouthed on assessment presented with solid square blocky mouths, could be missing the odd wing tooth - years of breeding ahead. These ewes would suit a short term trading opportunity or are a nice starter mob to breed some quality dorper lambs.
