All lambs were put over the scales at assessment and anything under 44kg was drafted off and put in another lot that is in this same sale. All the hard work is done as they are late December shorn, drenched and vaccinated and have also been grain trained. Hakrumun have been breeding Poll Merinos for 3 generations and select for good clean heavy cutting sheep while still maintaining great fertility. Noted at assessment that there was approx 10 lambs with wether horn which is obviously a throw back somewhere along the line. Lambs have never had a set back and are on the improve since trail feeding Faber Beans in the past few weeks. Lambs have plenty of frame to hang some weight on. At assessment lambs had a weight range of 44-59kg to avg 48.3kg after an overnight curfew. Vendor also has another lot of 201 wethers in the same sale that avg 39.4kg
