Of the 330 heifers assessed, noticed 18 with small percentage of warts around head, 1 with half tail, 15 with white on udder, 2 with white on naval & 6 with slight blue eye. Heifers will be sold in 3 lots of 110 head, a run out the gate in 3 even lines to the best of our ability.
