This line of first calvers were purchased as part of a larger lot of PTIC heifers out of SA, ex AuctionsPlus, before being calved down & mothered into smaller lines. Heifers present as mostly good to medium in frame, with the odd heifer showing a little more stretch & height. They are producing plenty of milk, which is nourishing a very even line of marked & vaccinated BLACKSTONE ANGUS sired calves at foot, & they have been running continuously back with the vendors TeMania Angus bulls since calving, however continued joining would be advisable due to the young age of the calves. Presenting in fresh store condition these heifers are cleaning up in the coat, & would put considerable weight on quickly with access to fresher, more available feed. A great opportunity to secure very good quality, exceptionally quiet, young breeders with sappy Angus calves at foot & a lifetime of production ahead of them.
